<b>\$230,450</b>	<b>\$411,500</b>	<b>33%</b>
<b>\$411,500</b>	<b>\$464,850</b>	<b>35%</b>
<b>\$464,850</b>	<b>And over</b>	<b>39.6%</b>

## Married Filing Separately

<b>\$37,450</b>	<b>\$75,600</b>	<b>25%</b>
<b>\$75,600</b>	<b>\$115,225</b>	<b>28%</b>
<b>\$115,225</b>	<b>\$205,750</b>	<b>33%</b>
<b>\$205,750</b>	<b>\$232,425</b>	<b>35%</b>
<b>\$232,425</b>	<b>And over</b>	<b>39.6%</b>
